Since 1990, with the opening of the Nightingale House at Wright-Patterson AFB, our military and Veteran community has seen Fisher House I open in May 1994, Fisher House II open in April 2011, and the Dayton VA Medical Center Fisher House open in October 2018.

The three Dayton-area Fisher Houses serve families of all ranks, branches of the armed forces and all components, including active duty, Guard, Reserve, retired, and Veterans. More than 1,200 families a year are assisted annually by these three Fisher Houses and they have assisted nearly twenty-five thousand families in 31 years of existence.
